SIT10216 Certificate I in Hospitality comprises of Six (6) units of competency. Package rules are Three (3) core units and Three (3) electives units they are indicated with * in the below list.

Course Duration

SIT10416 Certificate I in Hospitality is timetabled four (4) days a week, **Monday to Thursday 9 am - 3 pm**. It can be completed over a ten week (3) month period with full-time study.

Training Location & Modes of Delivery

Training is conducted onsite at Tauondi Aboriginal College utilising the Tauondi Training Kitchen.*. Training is delivered through a blend of Trainer led classes, presentations, practical and demonstrations. Students work through manuals, learning activities, group work, online learning activities and accredited assessments in a supported and nurturing environment. Your course may also include excursions and external visits to the hospitality industry and partner organisations to further your learning. *Note 2

Entry Requirements

The eligibility criteria are vital in ensuring successful completion of the Certificate. Applicants must meet the minimum requirements for enrolment, including:

- Be a minimum of 17 years of age
- Be of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent
- Possess a valid Unique Student Identifier (USI)
- Complete a Tauondi LL&N assessment
- Physical capabilities required to successfully complete training and assessment requirements as per qualifications

Fees

This qualification is provided to eligible Aboriginal and Torres Strait students at no charge.

Other Costs

Students must acquire required uniforms and personal protective equipment (PPE) prior to commencement of the qualification. Students not in required uniform and PPE will not be allowed to participate in practical classes. Requirements include:

- **ESSENTIAL** - Sturdy closed-in black shoes with non-slip soles (not sneakers or canvas shoes)
- **ESSENTIAL** - Black long sleeved top (either collared shirt or polo)
- **ESSENTIAL** - Long black work pants
- **OPTIONAL** - Formal black shirt with collar



Recognised Prior Learning
