In doing so organisations that work with families, children and young people are mandated to ensure their staff complete a form of Safe Environments training every three years.

- Recognise the impact of abuse and neglect on children.
- Appropriately respond to suspicions of abuse and neglect and make necessary reports.
- Provide appropriate support to families and children at risk.
